**LEGAL REVIEW:** PRIME MINISTER A.N.R. Robinson, third from right, holds discussions yesterday with three overseas members of the legal and forensic team representing Government in its anti-corruption suits and investigations in the United States and Canada. It was announced that the team from the US and Canada presented a thorough review of the cases and that discussions will continue today. Matters included:

- The TT\$12 million out-of-court settlement by US-based Tesoro Corporation in the claim related to alleged bribery payments to former Minister John O'Halloran and officials of the former People's National Movement (PNM) Government.

- A claim filed in Canada by Government against the estate of O'Halloran (who died in 1985) to recover funds allegedly obtained fraudulently by the late Minister.
